- Please make sure that you are updating ag mechanics project record books with regards to judge's feedback.
- ATMS, AAE, and Entomology: Please make sure that you are reviewing resources, previous exams, and test banks to prepare for contests. These are FREE points that you CANNOT leave on the table!

## Hubbell:

- Floral: Please make sure that you are reviewing resources, previous exams, and QBank to prepare for contests. These are FREE points that you CANNOT leave on the table!
- Poultry: Please utilize your binder and QBank to help you study parts ID, carcasses, specific chapter questions, etc.
- Horse: Please make sure you are utilizing iCEV nationals videos.
- Cotton: Please make sure you are coming to my shop to practice with the samples
- If you are interested in participating in Public Speaking, district contest is May 1st and you need to come see me.
- If you are interested in showing a steer or heifer next year at GCFA or any Texas majors, please come and see me.
- **\*\*NEW\*\* FOR 2023** all state validated heifers will be tagged similar to steers. This will bring the heifer validation program in line with breeding sheep, breeding goats, and breeding gilts.
- **\*\*NEW\*\* FOR 2023** both steers and heifers will be charged at \$25 per validation fee
- Cattle Validation Tag ordering will begin **March 1, 2023**. The deadline for tag ordering will be **April 7, 2023**.

## Ross:

- Swine Validation Tag ordering will begin April 1, 2023. The deadline for tag ordering will be April 30, 2023.
- Swine Tags: \$15 -April 1st-30th, \$18 May 1st- June 7th

## New for 2023 State Fair of Texas / Heart of Texas Validation

- We will be using 840 USDA Premise ID Tags for validation.
- If the pig has an 840 tag from a breeder in it's ear at time of validation, that tag will need to be removed and replaced with our program issued 840 validation tag. \*\*\* Please note that the Texas Animal Health Commission has approved the removal of 840 tags in animals that have been purchased for show purposes in Texas as our tag will be the tag of record.
- If an 840 tag is removed at time of validation, the number will need to be recorded for reference in a document provided at time of validation.
- If a validation tag is lost, it MUST be replaced with an 840 validation tag. If you replace the 840 validation tag with your personal 840 tag, or a 840 breeder tag or a veterinarian issued 840 tag, your pig(s) will be considered as NON – VALIDATED, RESULTING IN YOUR PIG(S) NOT BEING ELIGIBLE FOR SHOW.
- Recommended tagger - Datamar (Blue) Universal Tagger.
- **Lamb and Goat Validation Tag ordering will begin March 1, 2023.** The deadline for tag ordering will be **April 7, 2023.**

**\*NEW FOR 2023\*** Lambs and goats validated during the 2023 State Fair Validation Period **WILL BE ELIGIBLE** for 2024 Spring Major Shows. Market animals validated for the 2023 State Fair will carryover for 2024 Spring Major Shows. Once validated, the project **MUST** stay in the care of the exhibitor that project is validated to; if the exhibitor chooses to sell the project to a new exhibitor, the new exhibitor **MUST REVALIDATE** the project within the next validation period. Please see the Validation Guidelines for more details.

- Lamb and Goat Tags: \$15 per head **March 1st- April 7th**, \$25 per head **April 8th- June 24th**
- **Physical Validation:** June 1st-30th, 2023
- **Vet Science:** Please make sure you are reading your chapters and working on practicum practice. You also need to be memorizing your ID list. Get with Ross with available days for practices ASAP!
- **Lonestar degree applicants the deadline for submission is May 5th**, so you need to be making sure your record book is up to date.
- **Nursery:** Please make sure that you are reviewing your resources, exams, and test banks to prepare for contest. These are FREE points that you CANNOT leave on the table.
